

The Surrogacy Sisterhood was established to support surrogates in all parts of their surrogacy experience.


Surrogacy is a perpetual journey - so whether you are new to surrogacy or gave birth a long time ago, the Sisterhood is for you.

Sarah-Jayne Duryea, psychologist (the other SJ)




TRAVEL TO EILDON


Eildon is a two-hour drive from Melbourne airport.
